- Do you suffer from **Diabetes mellitus** (high blood sugar)?



- Do you suffer from **Hypertension** (high blood pressure)?



- Have you observed any **reduction in urine amount**?



- Do you notice your **urine** to be very **frothy (bubbly)**?



- Do you see any **blood in urine** / red- black colored urine?

- Do you have **swelling** over any body parts (legs, face, hands)?



- Do you have **family history** of kidney diseases / dialysis OR kidney transplantation?




- Do you have a history of **kidney stones** or recurrent **urine infections**?

- Do you take **pain medicines** (NSAIDs: Ibuprofen, Diclofenac, Ketorolac, Naproxen)?



- Are you **overweight** or **obese**?



- Do you have **liver** or **heart** problems?

If your answer is **YES** to any of the above questions, you may have or be at increased risk of kidney diseases. Please see a Nephrologist (Kidney doctor) for more information and testing.
